Joe Carcia processed six Code Proficiency certificates and two endorsements. He also updated the web code practice files and their archives.

Joe began construction of a doublet antenna that will eventually replace the TennaDyne multiband antenna currently installed on the Satellite tower. Using a SDRPlay RSP2Pro (on loan from the Lab), Joe began testing for a replacement to the Hamtronics R139 Satellite WEFAX receiver—a receiver that is showing signs of failure. The R139 has been in operation at W1AW for a number of years, and was used to demonstrate WEFAX reception, especially during Teachers Institute sessions.

Scott Gee, WB9RRU, processed nineteen electronic VUCC applications for a total of 1013 credits. He also worked on slow and fast code practice files for the week.
