Joe Carcia processed eleven Qualifying Run certificates and four endorsements. He also processed regular QSL card requests.

Joe has been in contact with Dave Freese, W1HKJ, the author of *fldigi* (http://www.w1hkj.com/). The *fldigi* program is used at W1AW to handle all the scheduled digital bulletin transmissions. It's also used for visitor digital activity as well. The plan is to have *fldigi* handle all the scheduled CW practice and bulletin transmissions, in addition to the digital transmissions, and have a final working version of the software ready for release January 2020.
