In advance of the March 5 nomination deadline for this spring season's election cycle, incumbent Utah Section Manager Mel Parkes, NM7P, and Pat Malan, N7PAT, submitted nominating petitions to run for the next term of office that begins July 1, 2021; therefore, there will be one Section Manager election this spring in Utah.

As previously reported in the IN News, the following Section Managers were nominated for new terms of office. Since they have no opposition, they have been declared elected to start their new two-year terms of office on July 1. They are Marty Pittinger, KB3MXM (Maryland-DC); John Bigley, N7UR (Nevada); Bob Buus, W2OD (Northern New Jersey); Bob Beaudet, W1YRC (Rhode Island); John Litz, NZ6Q (San Joaquin Valley); and Dale Durham, W5WI (West Texas). In New Hampshire, Pete Stohrer, K1PJS, was the only nominee, so he will succeed John Gotthardt, K1UAF, as Section Manager on July 1.

Product Development

We've prepared ARRL's participation for the QSO Today Virtual Ham Expo, which will be held March 13-14. ARRL has been promoted as a QSO Today partner. Key areas of our participation include David Minster's keynote which will be delivered during the event on Sat, Mar 13 at 3 PM Eastern time (2000 UTC). Since all of the forums and presentations are pre-recorded, David's keynote was video-recorded here in the HQ lobby which was transformed into a studio last Saturday. Sixteen of our staff will support two booths in the virtual exhibit hall, including a general ARRL booth and one for the ARRL Lab featuring "Ask the Lab" and short tours from inside W1AW. We'll keep these exhibit hours: 8 AM to 5 PM PST on Saturday, and 8 AM to 1 PM PDT on Sunday. Many ARRL member-volunteers also pepper the large schedule of presentations. Like last August's event, we'll receive much data from the organizers about the event including registrant information and activity. There's still time to register to 'attend.' Over the last two weeks, Bob Inderbitzen, NQ1R, participated in meetings for the Management Council, Product Development Department, development of the future Public Relations & Outreach Department, planning for a future Student Membership Challenge, PR Committee, ideas for a Field Day pullout in *QST*, and with subject matter experts preparing a Cycle 25 primer. Bob also provided support for website testing.

Bob produced videos for David Minster's keynote for the QSO Today Expo, a W1AW tour for the Learning Network featuring Joe Carcia, NJ1Q, and a W1AW training video for internal use.

At our invitation, Josh Nass, KI6NAZ, of the popular YouTube channel Ham Radio Crash Course completed an interview with the director of the short sci-fi horror film about SuitSat, DECOMMISSIONED. The interview also includes Frank Bauer, KA3HDO, Chairman for ARISS. The interview is published on ARRL's YouTube channel and included a live premier on Feb 27: https://youtu.be/sqijZppQPWw

We worked with member-volunteer J. Mitch Hopper, K9ZXO, who helped produce a 2021 ARRL Field Day primer for us. A second version includes Spanish-language subtitles. The videos will be published next week to ARRL's YouTube channel, and will premier as part of our exhibit at the QSO Today Expo, Mar 13-14.

Bob has migrated the monthly ARRL Collegiate Amateur Radio webinars from GotoMeeting to Zoom. The change responds to feedback shared by students of campus radio clubs. Details can be found at www.arrl.org/WeWantU
