February ended with 156,516 members, putting us 300 members behind year-to-date goal. A gain of 159 members was forecast; we lost 165. New ham acquisition continues to lag a bit. As mentioned in last month's report, the first two communications to this group no longer asks them to join but rather introduces them to ARRL and tells them about our suite of *On the Air (OTA)* resources (magazine, podcast and blog). The *on-time* renewal rate for February expirees was 69% vs. 69% last February. We have 6,576 current member *OTA* print magazine subscribers.

Diane participated in 19 meetings last week with Personify in addition to several meetings in the first three weeks of the month.

#### **Sales and Marketing**

Jackie Ferreira, KB1PWB, reports that:

- February product sales were \$228,764, falling short of the sales forecast of \$248,882.
- Direct sales were \$146,592; dealer sales were \$82,172. Direct sales are up \$10,530 from February 2019.
- Royalties earned on sales of our Kindle e-books were \$5,551 (\$12,233 YTD; \$14,000 forecast).
- Sales at our exhibit at the convention in Orlando contributed \$9,763.

Jackie shared some good results from the "Winter Blowout "email campaign" contributing sales of over \$63,000. A total of 7,709 units of books and DVD's were ordered online during the 6-week promotional sale. A big thanks goes to Jackie for her contributions to making this a successful campaign!

There were 638 online orders placed over the Leap year weekend, kicking off March with over \$30,000 in sales.

Steve Capodicasa reports that it was a busy month at the warehouse. Spurred-on by a handful of promotions conducted by email -- we enjoyed high levels of ordering activity. There were 5,368 parcels shipped in the month of February. That is the most we've had in 16 years!



Each year, a new ARRL Field Day logo is introduced to help promote our biggest annual on-air operating event. This year's logo design has been finalized, with creative input from Kathleen Callahan, KC1MBY, Norm Fusaro, W3IZ, Bob Inderbitzen, NQ1R, and Yvette Vinci. Eric Casey has been working with a handful of vendors to commit orders for our 2020 ARRL Field Day merchandise: t-shirts, pins, mugs, stickers, etc. The product line will become available in early April.

A low profile (5000 lb. capacity) pallet scale was purchased for the ARRL warehouse to generate better efficiency and accuracy with palletized freight shipments. Palletized shipments had been handled manually where each individual piece had to be weighed by hand and tallied up on a notepad. That resulted in decreased efficiency, led to inaccurate weight calculations and freight carrier reweigh inspections. The pallet scale will prove to solve these issues. Special thanks to Greg Kwasowski for overseeing the installation process.
