Sales and Marketing

Reported by Bob Inderbitzen, NQ1R

Publication and product sales in May were \$300,616, exceeding the forecast of \$255,186. Direct sales were \$185,931; dealer sales were \$114,686. Year-to-date sales are \$1,246,797; \$29,476 ahead of forecast. In May, *Grounding and Bonding for the Radio Amateur* contributed \$22,396 (1,217 units sold), *More Arduino Projects for Ham Radio* contributed \$18,000 (620 units sold), and 2017 ARRL Field Day supplies (t-shirts, hats, pins, patches, mugs, etc.) contributed sales of \$43,074. Sales at our exhibit at Hamvention® contributed \$42k to direct sales (\$50.8k in 2016). Royalties earned on sales of our Kindle e-books in May were \$8,035 (\$39,944 year-to-date).

Tom Gallagher and Bob Inderbitzen attended the ARRL Northwestern Division Convention, SEA-PAC, June 2-4 in Oregon. Bob visited the four all-day technical workshops held on Friday, including a packed Raspberry Pi workshop. He took photos and videos, some of which were posted to ARRL's <u>Facebook</u>

page. Attendance topped 2,100 by Saturday. The ARRL booth was supported by Division and Section leadership. With help from Lisa Tardette, Ham Radio Outlet carried our newest publiccccations in their booth (sales were brisk!). Bob returned with 85 membership applications, and total dues and contributions of \$6,457 (\$4,316 in 2016). Among the new ARRL members signed at SEA-PAC were three youth – all new licensees. Bob offered closing remarks on behalf of ARRL before the big end-of-convention prize drawing.

ARRL has received payment of \$4,918 for commissions earned on new and renewal subscriptions of RFinder made during the first quarter, 2017 (\$6,975 Q4 2016; \$23,532 for FY 2016). ARRL established an agreement with RFinder, creator of a web and app-based directory of Amateur Radio repeaters, in February 2016 to be our preferred online resource of repeater frequencies. ARRL earned \$5,239 in May for royalties attributed to the ARRL Visa Credit Card. The largest source of program growth is email conducted by ARRL on behalf of U. S. Bank. YTD (Jan-May), ARRL has earned \$19,111 (\$17,256 Jan-May 2016). There are 2,692 open cards. Card holder sales volume was over \$3.1 million YTD. ARRL earns royalties on newly opened cards and on net purchases.
