Field Services

Steve Ewald, WV1X

On May 18, Pat Malan, N7PAT, was declared the winner of the Utah Section Manager election in his race against incumbent Section Manager Mel Parkes, NM7P. Mel, of Layton, has served as Utah Section Manager for 22 years. Pat will begin his term of office on July 1. Ballots were counted and verified at ARRL Headquarters by Leona Adams, W1LGA, Kathy Bouchard, and Steve Ewald.

As reported previously in this newsletter, Pete Stohrer, K1PJS, was the only nominee to run for the next term of office as Section Manager when the nomination period closed on March 4. Pete will succeed John Gotthardt, K1UAF, of Wolfeboro, who decided not to run for a new term of office. Pete, of Concord, is returning to the SM position that he held previously from July 2013 to mid-2019.

The following incumbent Section Managers did not face opposition and were declared re-elected to begin new terms of office on July 1: Marty Pittinger, KB3MXM (Maryland-DC); John Bigley, N7UR (Nevada), Bob Buus, W2OD (Northern New Jersey), Bob Beaudet, W1YRC (Rhode Island), John Litz, NZ6Q (San Joaquin Valley); and Dale Durham, W5WI (West Texas).

Jim Siemons, W6LK, the ARRL Section Manager of East Bay, has announced that he will be stepping down from the position because he is relocating to Wyoming. Jim, presently of Walnut Creek, has been Section Manager since July of 2018. Jim recommended to Radiosport and Field Services Manager Bart Jahnke, W9JJ, that Mike Patterson, N6JGA, be appointed as his replacement. After consulting with Pacific Division Director Kristen McIntyre, K6WX, Bart officially appointed Mike Patterson as East Bay Section Manager, effective, June 1, 2021, to serve out the balance of Jim's term that extends to the end of this year, December 31, 2021. Mike is from Walnut Creek, California.

Leona Adams reports that Sacramento Valley Section Manager Carol Milazzo, KP4MD, has been nominated to run for a new term of office. Nominating petitions for this election cycle are due at ARRL Headquarters by June 4, and the new term of office begins on October 1, 2021.

On Tuesday, May 18, Joe Carcia participated in a Lifelong Learning webinar showcasing the W1AW Antenna Farm. Some technical issues had precluded the use of a narrated video recorded the week prior. With Kris Bickel, K1BIC, moderating and Steve Goodgame, K5ATA, remotely running the PowerPoint Presentation, Joe narrated live the presentation. On Friday, that same presentation was premiered on ARRL's YouTube channel. Joe was present during the premier to "Live Chat" and answer any questions posed about the antenna farm. He also completed the construction of the EMI filter test box to be used by the Lab.

Joe and Norm Fusaro, W3IZ, moved Hiram Percy Maxim's rolltop desk from the W1AW foyer to the ARRL lobby area for display.

Thanks to Bob Inderbitzen, NQ1R, for operating W1AW during the Hamvention QSO Party (https://hamvention.org/qso-party-2021/) on May 22. He made 123 and 186 SSB QSOs on 40- and 20-meters, respectively, for a total of 309 QSOs.
